- Coach, develop, mentor, and manage performance of direct reports, participate in the interviewing process for new hires on the operations team, and coordinate employee skills training and professional development opportunities.
- Create and promote a safe work environment that consists of accountability and ownership, identify, and communicate workplace hazards and correct unsafe actions or conditions, and participate in the company safety management system.
- Work with the lead hand to coordinate rail movements for the site and coordinate with rail companies on local service and unit trains.
